Protect Yourself from Identity Thieves

Identity theft is one of the fastest growing crimes in the country. At LCLFCU, we are doing all we can to help protect you. Along with providing the identity protection tips below, we also have a privacy policy to help ensure that your identity is safe.

Follow these tips to protect yourself from identity theft:

- Keep your Social Security card and passport in a safe place. Do not carry them with you unless absolutely necessary.
- Limit the amount of identifying information, including credit cards, you carry.
- Shred all financial information, such as unsolicited convenience checks, applications and bank statements.
- Do not give out information by phone, unless you initiated the call or know the person.
- Pay attention to billing cycles and follow up if bills don't arrive on time.
- Report lost or stolen checks or cards to us immediately. We will block payments on the check numbers and cancel your card.
- Closely guard your Personal Identification Number (PIN) and transaction receipts.
